# 4) What to bring: Classroom Session

# NO LIVE AMMUNITION IN THE CLASSROOM AREA

Under no circumstances are you allowed to bring ANY live ammunition into the classroom itself and this includes concealed handgun permit holders and law enforcement personnel.

Your firearms and ammunition will remain locked in your vehicle during classroom sessions.

## Please use the following as your checklist of what to bring to the classroom session:

- Black or blue ink ballpoint pen
- Sharpened pencils OR mechanical pencils with sufficient lead and eraser.
- Notebook for taking notes.
- We will take a short lunch break:
  - A fridge and microwave will be available to you if you decide to bring a lunch.
  - You may run and grab lunch and/or order delivery at this time.

### **Required Documents**

PRINT and COMPLETE the attached required documents AND bring them with you too the course.

Bring a water bottle, snacks, a lunch, etc. as you see fit.

## 5) What to bring: Range Session

The range session is planned for the Chaffee County Public Shooting Range, which is an outdoor range located next to the county landfill. While on the range, the following attire will be required:

- Crew neck or other high neck shirt, sweatshirt, or jacket
- Long pants
- Closed-toe shoes or boots for field conditions

Based upon the season and weather conditions, you should bring the following:

- Sunscreen
- Ballcap / Beenie
- Different types of jackets, rain slick or poncho
- Gloves
- Sunglasses

Be prepared for ANY and ALL weather conditions! We will not reschedule this program unless extreme weather conditions will render the live-fire session unsafe. It is recommended that you dress in layers instead of bringing one coat.

## Please use the following as your checklist of what to bring to the classroom session:

- **Eye and Ear protection.** Electronic muffs are strongly recommended, however you may use passive muffs or good plugs if that is all you have available to you.
- Range bag, case, or holster
- If you have folding outdoor rated chair(s) that are easily accessible, consider bringing these items for use in our range bay.
- You will need between 100 200 rounds (as the final round count will depend upon the need to repeat some exercises)
- You may shoot your preferred, defensive type semi-auto in any caliber from .380 up to .45 ACP OR revolver handgun in any caliber from .380 up to .38 Special.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- .22 caliber handguns are not preferred, however, if this is the only caliber handgun you have available to you, please bring it along.
- NO +P, +P+, or magnum ammunition.
- If you have any questions regarding your firearm or ammunition, please include them in your email response.

# 6) IMPORTANT!

Health Warnings - Please Read Carefully!

Potential health warnings for women who are, or may be, pregnant and for nursing mothers:

- Exposure to lead is a special concern during pregnancy, nursing and for young children below the age of eight.
- Loud noises at the decibel levels found on a shooting range should be avoided during pregnancy.
- Exposure to gun cleaning solvents and other chemicals may be harmful.

Please consult with your physician before attending any range session if any of the above applies to you.

# All Students

- Do not touch your face, eat or smoke after shooting until you have thoroughly washed your hands and face with soap and cold water.
- Changing your shirt/blouse and a shower are recommended as soon as possible after the range session.
- NO SMOKING in the classroom buildings and anywhere on the range (except completely inside of your vehicle).
